



2010 Student Volunteer Awards

Volunteerism enriches our community and makes many activities and resources available that would not otherwise exist. Volunteering as a student, can lead to continued participation in this valuable life-long activity. It also can lead to developing career, scholarship, and recognition opportunities for those students involved.

To encourage our youth to participate in this valuable life-long activity, the Jacksonville Area Chamber of Commerce sponsors the annual **Mayors' Student Volunteer Award** and the **President's Volunteer Service Award**. The purpose of these awards is to recognize and honor students who have enriched the area served by the Jacksonville Area Chamber of Commerce through their volunteerism over the past year. These awards will be presented by area Mayors and Village Presidents at the annual recognition reception in the spring of 2011.

To recognize the importance of volunteerism for our community and for the nation, students are eligible to receive both the Mayors' Award and the President's Award in accordance with the number of hours contributed in a calendar year. Information about both awards is included here. One application and service record can be used to apply for both awards. All applications and documentation are due to the Chamber of Commerce office no later than February 1, 2011.

Mayors' Student Volunteer Award Criteria

- Students – ages 6 to 21: 75 hours or more

President's Volunteer Service Award Criteria

- Children – 14 and younger: Bronze (50 to 74 hours)
Silver (75 to 99 hours)
Gold (100 hours or more)
- Young Adults – ages 15 to 25: Bronze (100 to 174 hours)
Silver (175 to 249 hours)
Gold (250 hours or more)

The President's Volunteer Service Award is issued by the President's Council on Service and Civic Participation on behalf of the President of the United States to recognize the best in the American spirit, and to encourage all Americans to improve their communities through volunteer service and civic participation.

The Jacksonville Area Chamber of Commerce is a certifying organization for the President's Volunteer Service Award. All volunteer hours should be documented on the following forms, using as many sheets as necessary. The President's Awards that are available are based on the age of the student and the number of hours of volunteer service.

Application forms should be submitted to the Chamber of Commerce by February 1, 2011.

Student Volunteer Awards

General Criteria

- The student must meet the age requirements.
- The student's volunteer hours can be done at one or more locations in one calendar year.
- The volunteer hours may take place at civic organizations, other schools, summer school, churches, hospitals, the Chamber of Commerce, nursing homes, environmental organizations, service organizations, camp, tutoring, mentoring, etc.
- The student must not be paid for their activities.
- The adult (non-family member) supervising the volunteer activity must verify the volunteer hours.
- The school principal and student must complete and submit the application form along with the completed verification forms.
